

Danby Township Regular Meeting Minutes
March 26, 2015

The regular meeting was called to order at 7:01 p.m. at the Danby Township Hall, 13122 Charlotte Hwy. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment:

Township resident Shannon Pike inquired about when the notice regarding the special meeting held by the Committee of the Planning Commission on March 23, 2015 was made available to the public. Township Clerk Platte stated that the notice regarding the special meeting was posted at the township hall on March 19, 2015 and to the website on the evening of Sunday March 22, 2015.

Township resident Elaine Sanborn expressed safety concerns regarding mining truck traffic on Kent Street and school buses picking up school children.

Township resident Eric Berry expressed concerns regarding what type of real qualifying requirements are being proposed that would allow the measuring of both dust and noise population levels coming from the proposed Superior Asphalt mining site.

Ionia County Commissioner Julie Calley gave the following updates:

- an ORV ordinance for Ionia County was passed.
- 911 surcharge of .47 for capital improvement goes into effect the first part of July 2015.
- a reminder that the Smart911 is a free service to Ionia County Citizens, all you need to do is create a Safety Profile for their household which would include information they want 911 to have in the event of an emergency. Remember that when you call 911 with your cell phone Dispatch Center is not provided with your residential address, this would be the type of information you would want to include in your Safety Profile. - a reminder that the Commission of the Elderly is available at the township level.
